The Department of Mathematics at Auburn University Montgomery (AUM) is sponsoring its fourth Annual Sonia Kovalevsky Mathematical Sciences Day. Dr. Joan Nunnelley Powell, Assistant Professor of Mathematics, is the organizer of the event. The event is designed to encourage high school-aged women to consider careers in mathematics and the sciences. Sonia Kovalevsky Days have been organized by the Association for Women In Mathematics (AWM) and institutions around the country since 1985. The event is named in honor of Sonia Kovalevsky, who was the first woman to earn a doctorate in mathematics

Sonia Kovalevsky Mathematics High School Day is a program of mathematics activities for young women. High school teachers from throughout Alabama are invited to bring their female students to Montgomery to meet the AUM mathematics faculty, professional women who use math in their careers, and other high school students who are interested in math. We will have several workshops through which we hope to inspire the participants to continue their study of mathematics.

All participants will receive books and prizes. A pizza lunch will be also provided. For those groups traveling more than 100 miles round trip we can provide travel and hotel reimbursements.
